Agenda #4, JCSO Election Agreement. (See attached) Donovan Weeks made a motion to approve the agreement as presented. Angie Locke seconded. All voted aye.

Agenda # 5, Town Manager Position. Mike Weeks stated that we would like to have a workshop to discuss the position in further detail. All agreed to do so on Jan 17th @ 5pm.

Attorney Cox stated that he had spoken with Angie Locke and other members about the position. He suggested we extend the deadline. Tony Money made a motion to extend it to February 28th. Donovan Weeks seconded. All voted aye.

c.	Deliver, Set-Up, and Remove the Voter Check-In Devices (EViD), Digital Scan Equipment (DS200) for ballot tabulation and the Express Vote (ADA ballot marking device).
d.	Select, train, and pay all election workers needed for the election.
e.	The Supervisor of Elections shall serve on the Canvassing Board and oversee the Logic and Accuracy testing of the DS200 and Express Vote on a day selected by the SUPERVISOR.
f.	Provide technical support by phone or on site, if needed, for the EViD, DS200, and Express Vote.
g.	Process all requests for Vote-By-Mail ballots; mail out, receive, and secure all Vote-By-Mail ballots.

h. In coordination with all members of the Canvassing Board, the Supervisor or Elections shall conduct post-election audit.

i. Physically and digitally maintain all election records in accordance with

The City of **SNEADS** agrees to provide the following services:

- a. Qualify all candidates according to the Election Code and the **SNEADS** Charter, to include advertisement for the qualifying period. Must provide a copy of the ad to the SOE office.
- b. Qualifying week should be held the last week of January 2024 to ensure the coding of the ballot is completed timely, unless your charter states a specific date for qualifying.
- c. The Supervisor of Elections shall serve on the Canvassing Board and the city shall provide the names of two members of the Canvassing Board to the Supervisor on or before January 31, 2024.
- d. Agree to proof ballot within 24 hours of receiving the proof. If a proof is received during a holiday or weekend, agree to proof ballot within 24 hours of resuming normal business hours. Failing to proof the ballot in the time outlined above could result in additional fees related to the coding of the ballot.
- e. Educating their community that all Vote-By-Mail ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections office prior to 7:00PM on Election Day and that Vote-By-Mail ballots cannot be returned to city hall. The ballots can be mailed or dropped off at the Supervisor of Elections office during normal business hours with the exception of Election Day in which the SOE office will be open until 7:00 pm.

2. COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES.

- a. The Supervisor shall be compensated for conducting the **SNEADS** City Election on April 09, 2024, in the amount of \$300 plus the following reimbursed expenses of which itemized invoices will be provided to the city clerk:
- b. All postage for Vote-By-Mail ballots.
- c. All expenses related to coding of the ballot by Election Systems and Software.
- d. All expenses for election workers.
- e. All expenses for truck rental for delivery of equipment. If the truck is used to deliver equipment to more than one town on the same day, your town will pay a pro rata share of the truck rental expense.

f. Within 10 days of the completion of the election, the City of **SNEADS** will be provided an itemized invoice of the expenses incurred by the Supervisor of Elections in order to conduct their municipal election.

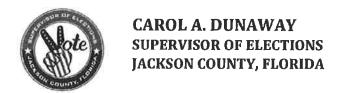
TERMS. This Agreement shall become effective on the date of its approval and shall only be effective for the City of SNEADS to be held on April 09.

Ordinance No. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SNEADS, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE TOWN MANAGER TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT OF RESIDENCY WITHIN THE TOWN REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Sneads, Florida, has previously adopted an Ordinance providing the qualifications and requirements of employment of its Town Manager, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Sneads, Florida, wishes to modify the residency requirements applicable to the Town Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Sneads, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. Town Manager Appointment, qualifications, removal:

- (a) The Town Council shall appoint a Town Manager upon such terms and for such compensation as the Town council may set. The Town Manager shall be an officer of the Town and shall have such powers and shall perform such other duties as the Town council may direct. No council member shall receive such appointment during the term for which he/she shall have been elected or appointed, nor within one year the expiration of his term as such Councilman.
- (b) The Town Manager shall be chosen by the Town Council solely on the basis of his/her executive and administrative qualifications with special reference to actual experience in or knowledge of, accepted practice in respect to the duties of his/her office. At the time of appointment, he/she need not to be a resident of the town or state, but the Town Manager's residence's distance from the town's limits shall not excuse unacceptable performance of the Town Manager's duties.
- (c) The Town Council may remove the Town Manager by a majority vote of the Town Council at any regular or Special Session. In the event of such a removal of the Town Manager, the Town Council shall adopt a resolution setting forth the removal effective date thereof. Upon removal of the Town Manager, the Town Council shall cause the Town Manager to be paid any accrued compensation as of the effective date of removal plus a sum equal to one month's salary as of the date of such removal.
- Section 2. Powers and duties: the Town Manager shall be the chief executive officer and the head of the administrative branch of the town government. He/she shall be responsible to the Town Council for the proper administration of all affairs of the town and to that end, he/she shall have the power and shall be required to:
- (a) Appoint and when necessary for the good of the Town, remove all employees of the Town except the Town Clerk, Town Attorney, Fire Chief and Police Chief. Appointment of or removal of the Town Clerk, Town Attorney, Fire Chief and Police Chief must be approved by a majority vote of the Town council.
- (b) Prepare the budget annually and submit it to the Town Council and be responsible for its administration after adoption.

(c) Prepare and submit to the Town council as of the end of the fiscal year a complete report on the finances and administrative activities of the Town for the preceding year.
(d) Keep the Town council advised of the financial condition and future needs of the Town and make such recommendations as may seem to him/her desirable.
(e) Submit annually to the Town a list of recommended capital improvements which in the opinion of the manager are necessary or desirable to be constructed during the forthcoming one-year period. Such a list is to be arranged in order of preference, with recommendations as to which projects shall be constructed.
(f) Perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the charter or required of him/her by the council, not inconsistent with the charter.
Section 3. Absence of Town Manager: To perform his/her duties during his/her temporary absence or disability, the town manager may designate a qualified administrative officer of the Town to perform the duties of the manager until he/she return.
Section 4. Town Council not to interfere in appointments or removals: Neither the council nor any of its members shall direct or request the appointment of any person to, or their removal from office by the Town Manager or by any of his/her subordinates, or in any manner take part in the appointment or removal of officers and employees in the administrative service of the Town except as provided in other sections of this ordinance. Except for the purpose of inquiry, the Council nor any member thereof shall give orders to any subordinates of the Town Manager, either publicly or privately without the knowledge of the Town Manager.
Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by the Town council.

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION FOR THE TOWN OF SNEADS, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an Election be called to elect **two** Council members for a regular term of two years for the Town of Sneads, Florida, City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SNEADS, FLORIDA:

That an Election for the Town of Sneads, Florida, for the election of **two** Council members for a regular term of two years is hereby called to be held on **Tuesday, April 9, 2024**, at the City Hall in the Town of Sneads, Florida, and

That each person qualifying for the offices mentioned above shall be qualified residents of the Town of Sneads, Florida, and shall be duly registered in the Registration Books for voters in the Town of Sneads. That the ballot shall be so prepared for said election that the names of the candidates for the **two** Council members to be elected for the full term of two years shall be placed on the ballot or voting machine in **Group I and II**, each candidate for the position of Council member shall qualify in one of such groups.

The designation "Council member" shall be printed on the ballot over each numbered group and each numbered group shall be clearly separated from the next numbered group so as to emphasize the necessity for voting for one candidate in each of the numbered groups.

An election shall be held on **April 9, 2024.** If a candidate for a Council Group receives a majority of the votes cast for all candidates for election for such office or if he/she has no opposition, he/she shall be declared elected for such office.

That each person who desires his/her name be placed on the ballot to be a candidate for the offices mentioned shall file his/her application in writing for his/her name to be placed upon said ballot with the City Clerk of the Town of Sneads, and shall, at the time of filing such application, pay the City Clerk an amount equal to 5.0% of the annual expense account of office being sought. All such fees paid shall be placed in the General Fund Account of the Town of Sneads, from which the expenses of holding the Town elections are paid. Filing of such applications shall begin at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, **February 19, 2024,** and shall end at 12:00 noon on Friday, **February 23, 2024**.

That any person who possesses the qualification to become a qualified elector or who is a qualified elector for the State and County elections in the State of Florida and in the County of Jackson, and who is a bona fide resident of the Town of Sneads, Florida, and who shall be duly registered in the Registration Book for voters in the Town of Sneads, Florida, shall be qualified to vote in said election.

We hereby appointed the **Jackson County Supervisor of Elections Office** over the Sneads Town election herein called. The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

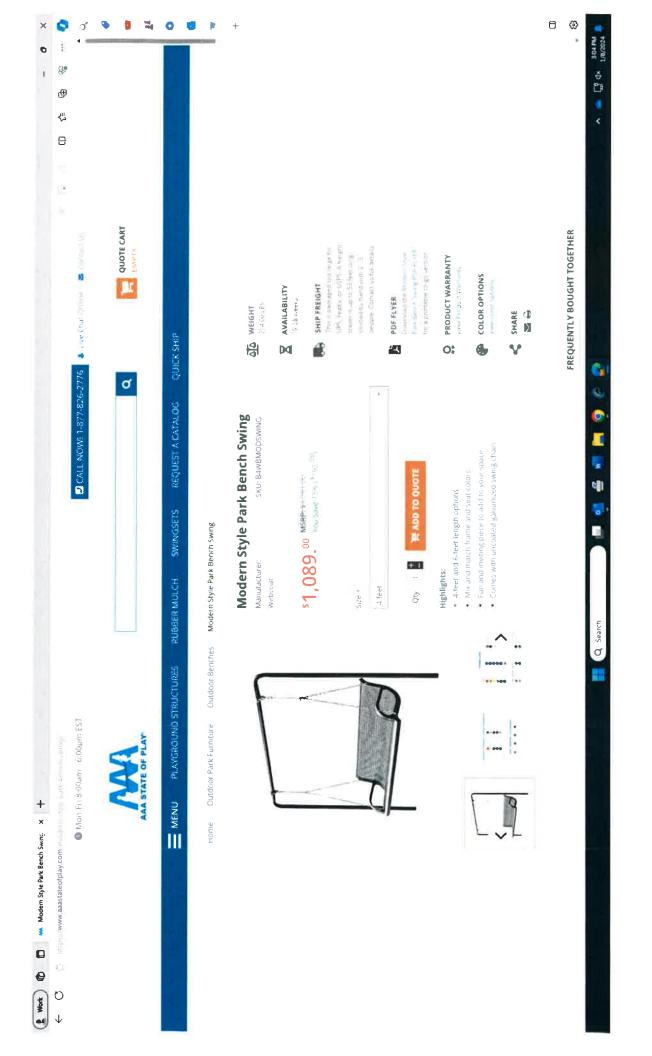

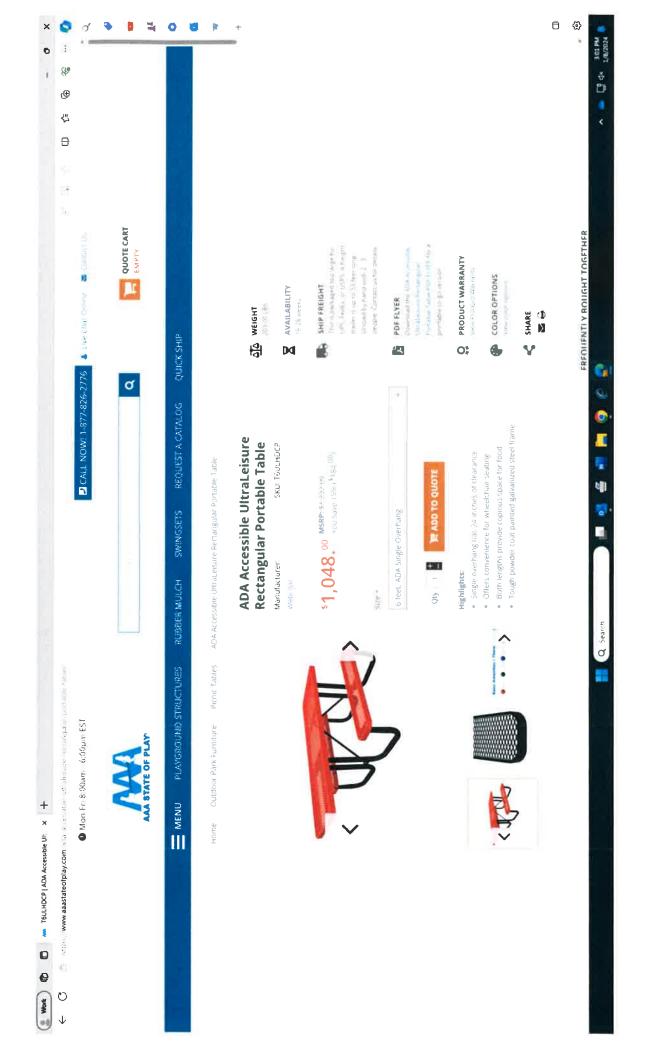
WHEREAS, the Town Manager is the chief executive officer of the Town government, and as such is responsible to the Town Council for the proper administration of all business affairs of the Town.

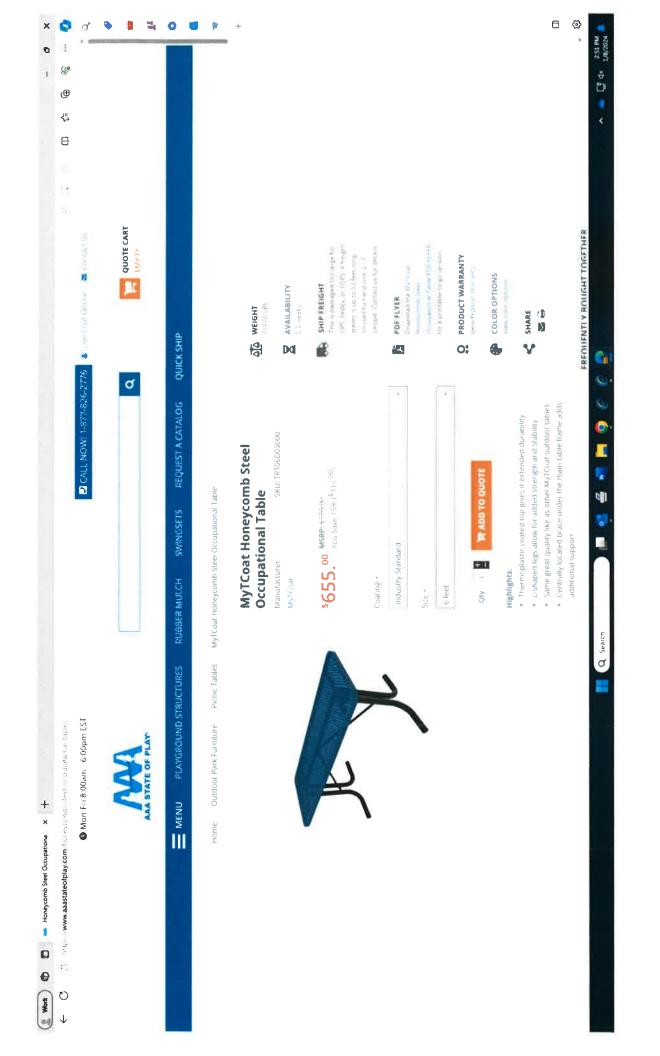

To whom it may concern,

On Tuesday, December 19, a site visit was conducted at 8083 Eugenia St. to determine whether a "tiny home" meets standards for homes set by the Town of Sneads, and if the home is safe and habitable.

This structure is a single wide sized 16x48 built in 2019, with a bedroom, a bathroom, living room, kitchen and laundry room. The foundation is masonry/concrete piers, and the structure is securely anchored with typical mobile home straps and anchors that are lag screwed to the main beams in the proper installation fashion. The floor framing is wood joist decked, as well as wood subflooring. The exterior walls are wood framed with exterior wood siding.

The home has a metal roof covering which is in good, working condition, a properly installed 200 amp Square D electrical panel, and PEX piping with no apparent supply leaks present. All windows, doors and locks are operable. The home currently uses a space heater that is sufficiently sized to heat the home as required by HUD. Taking the current condition of this home into consideration, it is a safe and livable structure. These structures are now generally engineered to specifications for Wind Zone 2.

This home appears to be structurally sound, and meets criteria listed in Ordinance No. 2019-03, and the "mobile home checklist" provided by the Town of Sneads.

- 1. On 1/5/24 Officers were involved in a high-speed pursuit which started in Sneads and ended near Greenwood. Officers were finally able to get the suspect stopped when he wrecked his vehicle. During the pursuit the suspect Elijiah Johnson attempted numerous times to wreck the pursuing Officers and put several other motorists in harm's way by forcefully running them off the

roadway. Once the suspect was stopped, he exited the vehicle in an aggressive manner and charged toward the officers, punching one officer in the face before fleeing on foot. After a lengthy foot pursuit, the Officers were able to catch up to the suspect and attempted to detain him. While trying to detain Johnson he continued to resist arrest while reaching for his waistband and pocket. Once Officers were able to detain Johnson, they discovered that he had a knife in his pocket that he was trying to reach for to cause harm to Officers. Johnson was eventually placed under arrest and transported by ambulance to Jackson Hospital with minor injuries. Another Officer also went to the hospital and treated for minor injuries. Once Johnson was medically cleared, he was transported to the Jackson County Correctional Facility where he is being held without bond due to an Active Arrest Warrant for VOP. Johnson was also charged with multiple Felony charges in reference to this incident. I would like to thank the deputies with the Jackson County Sheriffs Office for their assistance in this arrest.

2. Early this morning a severe storm moved through our area causing major damage in the county. I activated an emergency plan and had extra patrol on duty during the storm. Once the storm was clear, myself and other officers made our way to Marianna and other areas in the county to provide aid and assistance where needed. To my knowledge at this time Sneads did not receive any major damage and no injuries were reported in town. Please keep those affected by the storm in your thoughts and prayers.
