**Budget Summary**

**GENERAL FUND**

**MAY-** Revenues are 9.96% **over** budgeted amount. Expenditures are 25.86% **above** budgeted amount.

**GAS TAX**

**MAY -**Gas Tax Revenues are 5.04% **below** budgeted amount. Expenditures are 8.64% **below** budgeted amount.

**SOLID WASTE**

**MAY-** Garbage revenues are in line with budgeted amount. Expenditures are 2.86% **above** the budgeted amount.

**WATER AND SEWER**

**MAY -**ACI sewer is 14.56% **above** budgeted amount. Water sales are in line with the budgeted amount **above** 1.56%. Sewer Sales are 4.04% **below** budgeted amount. Expenditures are 2.86% **above** budgeted amount.

**RECREATION**

**APRIL-** Revenues are 49.99% **over** budgeted amount. Expenditures are 306.09% **over** budgeted amount.

**MAY-** Revenues are 41.66% **over** budgeted amount. Expenditures are 273.39% **over** budgeted amount.
