Budget Summary

GENERAL FUND

MAY- Revenues are 9.96% over budgeted amount. Expenditures are 25.86% above budgeted amount.

GAS TAX

MAY -Gas Tax Revenues are 5.04% below budgeted amount. Expenditures are 8.64% below budgeted amount.

SOLID WASTE

MAY- Garbage revenues are in line with budgeted amount. Expenditures are 2.86% **above** the budgeted amount.

WATER AND SEWER

MAY -ACI sewer is 14.56% above budgeted amount. Water sales are in line with the budgeted amount above 1.56%. Sewer Sales are 4.04% below budgeted amount. Expenditures are 2.86% above budgeted amount.

RECREATION

APRIL- Revenues are 49.99% **over** budgeted amount. Expenditures are 306.09% **over** budgeted amount. (Rec Park Lights Paid with Grant Funds)

MAY- Revenues are 41.66% over budgeted amount. Expenditures are 273.39% over budgeted amount. (Rec Park Lights Paid with Grant Funds)
